SJAM2- School Life- November 14, 2023

Literacy, math, well being:

P-6 Literacy: The UFLI lessons are in progress, and it is really supporting students with phonics and phonological awareness. We also have our two literacy coaches working one-on-one with teachers and also doing check ins and mini professional learning sessions with other teachers.

Math Focus: We continue to work with our two math coaches in English and French Immersion to ensure that small group instruction is happening to meet the needs of students. A solid 60 minutes (Grades 4-6) or 45 minutes (Primary to Grade 3) of uninterrupted math time along with 30 mins per day of fact fluency is consistent at every grade level.

Well Being: We continue to collaborate as a staff to determine action steps for our well being goal. We did have the Youth Project come in to do presentations to classrooms and a Students vs. Staff Dodgeball game.

Current school site update:

Gil-Son Construction Limited has been on site daily to regulate heat and to continue work on the natural gas heating system.

New school update:

No new news.

Bussing update: Nothing to report. Buses have been on time.

Staffing update:

We have one 80% EPA position left to fill. Working on filling the VP position for Emily's maternity leave.

Food Program at SJAM:

Our hot breakfast program has started. It is going well; the menu and schedule went out in schoolmessenger.

School Activities:

The Youth Project visited SJAM to deliver presentations to classes. Topics were age/grade appropriate: **P-3:** Reading a Storybook that facilitates discussions on diversity, kindness, respect, and friendship, **4:** Presentation and discussion about stereotypes around body, gender, and expression; Introduction of terms and topics related to gender affirming care and allyship, **5-6:** A 101 workshop that looks at gender identity, sexual orientation, homophobia, transphobia, and allyship. This is in partnership with the Department of Education & Early Childhood Education.

We also held a Remembrance Day assembly outdoors. We had classes that presented poems and songs, laying of the wreaths, and a moment of silence.

We are looking to confirm a venue for our Grade P-2 Winter Concert. Our choir will be participating in the North End Business Association Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremony on December 1st.
